

GENERAL INFORMATION

PURCHASING UNIFORM

HAIR

- Will be clean, tidy and off the face (long hair for boys and girls needs to be clipped; tied or held back by a band)
- Clips, ribbons, bands etc. must be of the school colours
- Style to be appropriate for primary school wear (fads and/or trends, e.g. Mohawks; lettering; rats tails or similar are not permitted)
- Colour enhancements should conform to natural tones.

JEWELLERY

- Is restricted to one plain gold or silver stud in each ear, a religious or cultural taonga in the form of a necklace and a watch.

MAKE UP

- Including nail polish and eye make up is not permitted

SUN HATS

- Regulation School Hat to be worn in Terms 1 & 4.

JACKETS

- Tidy Jackets are encouraged in wet / cold weather.

LOST PROPERTY

- Parents / students may check this at any time if belongings have been mislaid. It is the responsibility of the student to keep track of their belongings.
Please ensure all uniform is named.

EXTRA CLOTHING

- Any additional undergarments should not be visible when uniform is worn e.g. singlets, t-shirts, boxer shorts.

CYCLE HELMETS

- Approved cycle safety helmets to be worn by cyclists.

NOTE : The Principal has the right, on behalf of the Board of Trustees, to interpret the intent of all matters pertaining to school uniform and associated expectations.

UNIFORM EXPECTATIONS

- All students are expected to wear their choice of uniform in accordance with the regulations set down by the Board of Trustees as outlined within this brochure.
- Following the School Uniform Regulations / Policy is a condition of enrolment at this school.
- Students should wear the uniform with respect for themselves and pride in their school.
- Uniform should be clean and in good repair.
- Short-term exemption can be given for loss of articles or for unforeseen circumstances – please communicate this to the School Deputy Principal to enable the exemption to be actioned.
- If there are problems in providing a uniform – please see the Principal.
- Parents / Caregivers will be notified if deviation from uniform regulation is persistent.
- All items of clothing must be clearly named.

NOTE – Please attend to all uniform orders at an early opportunity – up to 6 weeks prior to need.

SHORT / TROUSER BASED REGULATION UNIFORM

SHORTS	Black (Cotton / Polyester)
TROUSER	Black Formal (Cotton / Polyester) (<i>Optional Terms 2 & 3</i>)
SHIRT	Short sleeved bottle green, black and white striped polo (with school monogram)
JERSEY	Bottle green sweatshirt (with school monogram)
OR	Bottle green polar fleece (with school monogram)
FOOTWEAR	Black shoes with Black and bottle green stripe socks
OR	Black ankle sandals without socks
SUNHAT	House Coloured Bucket Hat (<i>Compulsory Terms 1 & 4</i>)

SKIRT BASED REGULATION UNIFORM

SKIRT	Gordon Tartan – Optional N.E – Yr. 8
BLOUSE	White short sleeved blouse (with school monogram)
JERSEY	Bottle green sweatshirt (with school monogram)
OR	Bottle green polar fleece (with school monogram)
FOOTWEAR	Black shoes with Black knee length socks or Black tights
OR	Black ankle sandals without socks
SUNHAT	House Coloured Bucket Hat (<i>Compulsory Terms 1 & 4</i>)

P.E. / SPORTS REGULATION UNIFORM – Compulsory Yrs. 3-8

To be worn for P.E. / Sports & if desired at lunchtime – **not to be worn to and from school**

POLO SHIRT	- Bottle Green and Gold stripe polo shirt (with school monogram)
SHORTS	- Bottle Green
