Scootering and Cycling update

Our School Safety Policy has just been updated, please take note of the key points below. We will be teaching this through our Positive, Behaviour for Learning lessons.

Scootering/Cycling:

-All children who ride scooters to and from school and bring them to school will wear a cycle helmet correctly fitted and fastened.

-Scooters/bikes will be left in the rack within their syndicate area. Helmets can be kept in class in areas designated by the class teacher.

Scooterists/cyclists will dismount their scooter outside the entrance and walk it to the rack. On leaving they will walk their scooter outside the school entrance.

Scooterists/cyclists will respect pedestrians at all times.
